




Router passwords


Following the panorama TV program, we have provided this guide with information on how you can change your password for your Router.		
1	Each router manufacturer sets up their new routers with the same default username and password. The username is often simply the word "admin" or "administrator." The password is typically blank (meaning there is no password out of the box), the words "admin," "public," "password," or some other simple word choice. Obviously not difficult or secure passwords, because they are meant to be changed when the network is first set up.	
Q1	What is the purpose of a router?	Answer:
2	The default usernames and passwords for popular models of wireless network gear are well-known to hackers and often posted on the internet. If the default password isn't changed, any attacker or even a curious individual who comes within signal range of the router can log into it. Once inside, they can change the password to whatever they choose, locking the owner out of the router and effectively hijacking the network.	
3	Open your internet browser and type what is the sky default router password? Depending on the browser you are using you will see a variety of website pages displaying the relevant information.	<div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;">In the address bar, type 192.168.0.1 and press Enter. By default the username should be admin and the password sky (all in lowercase). If this doesn't work, check the base of your router for these details. From the Useful settings menu on the right hand side of the screen, select Change Wireless Password.</div>




7	<p>When you get home look at the back of your router and see if you can identify the Admin user name and password.</p>																			
8	<p>To change your admin router password, you would need to open an internet tab and type an address like http://192.168.0.1. This address would be on the back of your router. Alternatively type what is the (insert your internet providers name) default router password? This will provide you with an internet address number like above. Open a new internet tab and Type the address for your router.</p>
