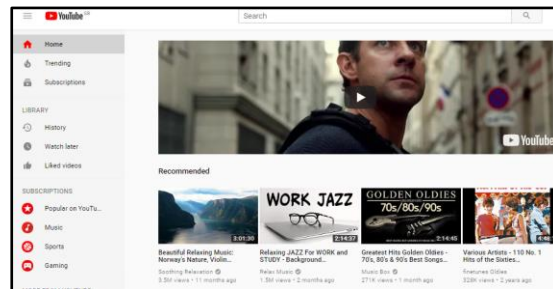
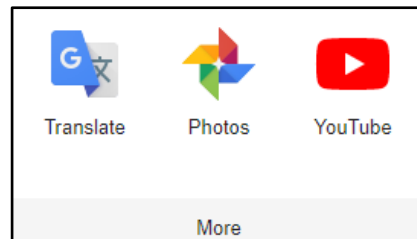
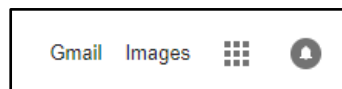




Session Booklet – YouTube

In this session we are going to look at YouTube. YouTube is a free video sharing website that makes it easy to watch online videos. You can even create and upload your own videos to share with others. Originally created in 2005, YouTube is now one of the most popular sites on the Web, with visitors watching around 6 billion hours of video every month. Today, we are looking at how YouTube is accessed and used via Google.

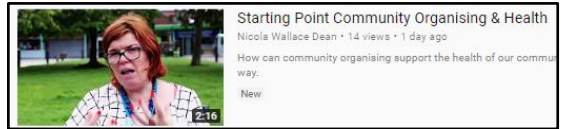

1	<p>Our first step is to go to Google. If Google is not your search engine then type this web address into your address bar: www.google.co.uk</p> <p>If using a tablet you may have an App for You Tube already install on your device.</p>
<p>Knowledge check Tablet users only. How would you obtain the You Tube App</p>	
2	<p>Locate and select the 9 squares at the top right of the page</p>
3	<p>We want to Select You Tube. If it is not displayed select more at the bottom of the list.</p>
4	<p>Now we are on the YouTube website, we need to search for a video to watch.</p> <p>At the top of the screen is a search bar. If you left-click/tap in the search bar, you'll be able to type a phrase that will bring up videos that match that phrase.</p>





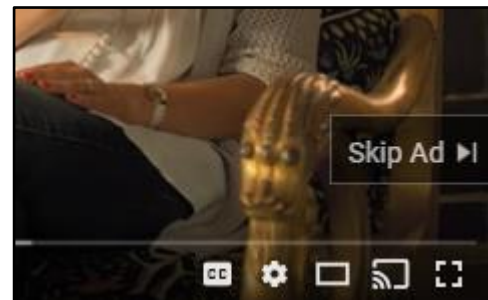

5 We are going to type 'Starting point community Woodley' in to the search bar, press enter or search. You are looking for the video that has the same thumbnail as the one on the right hand side and has been uploaded to YouTube by Nicola Wallace.

6 Now we've found the video we are looking for, we need to left-click/tap on it and the video will begin. Occasionally, when watching videos on YouTube, they are preceded by adverts. These adverts can be skipped select Skip Ad when displayed.

7 So you have better control of YouTube, we are going to highlight different settings you can change whilst watching a video. These symbols are along the bottom of the video. You may need to tap your screen or move your mouse to see these symbols if watching a video.










This symbol is the play button.





When the video is playing you can select the pause symbol.

This symbol will allow you to adjust the volume of the video itself and if you left-click/tap on the speaker symbol itself, it will mute the video completely.



	<p> This symbol produces subtitles/closed captions for the video. YouTube doesn't ask for a transcript of a video so these subtitles are automatically generated. This may result in inaccuracies.</p> <p> This symbol is the full screen symbol. This maximises the image to fill the screen to make watching it easier. To get out of full screen, you can tap back on the symbol or press the esc key found in the top left of the keyboard.</p>	
8	<p>As You Tube is part of Google anyone that has a Gmail / Google mail account will automatically have a Youtube account.</p> <p>You don't need a Gmail or Googlemail account to be able to watch videos on Youtube.</p>	
9	<p>If you have an account you can subscribe, comment and like videos.</p>	
10	<p>Look to the top right of your screen. If you have an account and you are signed into it you will see the first letter of your name or email address.</p>	
11	<p>If you do have an account and you are signed in you will be able to like the Starting Point community Video. Once you have liked the video a blue thumbs up will be displayed.</p>	
12	<p>If you are not signed in or don't have an account this message will be displayed.</p>	
13	<p>If you have an account you will be able to subscribe to specific and any time a new video is release it will be shown in your subscriptions.</p> <p>Subscribe to the Startingpoint community Video.</p>	



<p>14</p>	<p>If using a computer or Laptop click on the “You tube” logo top left to return to the beginning.</p> <p>If using a tablet select the icon at the bottom of the You Tube screen that says Home.</p>	
<p>15</p>	<p>On your laptop or tablet on the left of the screen you have this menu.</p> <p>This menu is accessible if you have a Gmail account and you are signed in to it.</p> <p>If you are using the You Tube App your menu will be along the bottom.of the screen.</p> <p>Select these different options to view whats available.</p> <p>Selecting History will show you all the previous videos you have watched.</p> <p>Subscriptions will show sites that you have subscribed too.</p>
