




## iLocate

Until the rise of online maps, cartography was restricted to a few companies, institutes and mapping agencies, requiring relatively expensive and complex systems and skilled cartographers and engineers.

Now there are maps available in a number of sources on the web. Data is owned and updated by companies like Navteq, Google, Waze and others.

This means we now have more access to maps than ever before. This is not only to show us how to get from A-B but also what happened on the land we stand on years before we were here.

<p>1</p>	<p><b>Introduction:</b> In this session we are going to look at various maps of one particular place. For the purposes of the exercise we are going to pick Edgeley at the back of Stockport Train Station.</p> <p>The postcode we will be using is <b>SK3 9HR</b>.</p> <p>This is Bengal Street.</p>	
<p>2</p>	<p><b>Google Maps:</b> From the main Google search screen at <a href="http://www.google.com">www.google.com</a> we are going to search for the postcode above. It doesn't matter if you type the postcode in lowercase or capitals. It also doesn't matter if you put spaces in between the postcode.</p> <p>Type in the postcode and press <b>Enter</b>.</p>	

<p>3</p>	<p><b>Search Result:</b></p> <p>The above steps will list all sorts of results for that postcode, but at the top of the results there is a map.</p> <p>You can click onto the map for more features.</p>	
<p>4</p>	<p><b>Map View:</b></p> <p>Once you have the map open in a full screen you will see a red pointer which will show you where your location is.</p> <p>In the bottom left hand corner, you can change your view from <b>Map</b> to <b>Satellite</b>.</p> <p>To do this click on the small box in the bottom left hand corner to see the different view and click on it again to switch back again.</p>	
<p>5</p>	<p><b>Peg man:</b></p> <p>In the bottom left hand corner, you will see more options. One of these is a small orange man. We refer to him as peg man.</p> <p>To move your peg man to your red marker:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Click onto the peg man</li> <li>• Keep your finger down on the mouse or screen</li> </ul>	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Drag to your red marker</li></ul> <p>The first few times you do this you might not get the right location. It just takes practice so don't worry on this occasion where the peg man has landed.</p>	
6	<p><b>Going for a virtual walk:</b></p> <p>You can move round the street view map by clicking onto your map and keeping your fingers down on the mouse or screen.</p> <p>Try changing direction.</p> <p>To move up and down the road you will see an arrow when you hover over a road. You can move up and down the road by clicking the arrow.</p>
