1.	Using your Internet browser search for the digital unite website.

3.	Where do you need to go on the website to find guides?	
4.	Once you have identified where to go on the website open the link (page) for the guides.	
5.	Select the relevant link (page) that will give you information about Email safety.

7.	<p>After looking at the page for email safety tips you may see a search box.</p> <p>Using this search box search for How to choose a password.</p>	
8.	<p>After reading about passwords.</p> <p>Name 3 things you shouldn't use as part of your password.</p>	<p>1.</p> <p>2.</p> <p>3.</p>
9.	<p>When assessing websites that you registered on, (create username &amp; password) you will be asked if you want your browser to remember your password.</p> <p>Why do people do this?</p> <p>Is this a safe idea?</p> <p>Do you know where you can assess your saved passwords on your web browser?</p>	
10.	<p>Open your internet Browser, you need to open the browsers settings.</p> <p>With the support of Ryan, Julie or the volunteers see if you can locate these settings.</p> <p>A clue, settings may be accessed by the 3 dots or 3 lines on your browser page usually top right.</p>	

11.	<p>It is easy to disclose information without even knowing you are doing it.</p> <p>When do you give information away without thinking about it, and what do companies do with it?</p>	
12.	<p>An example of giving information is when you register for ITV player.</p> <p>You will be asked: Your postcode, and your Date of Birth. Why do you think they ask you this information?</p>
