


Travel – Getting around Stockport

Travelling locally		
1	In this handout we are going to be looking at ways in which we can use local travel services to get around our borough. Most of the tasks will be multi-part tasks as you'll need to find locations and then work out travel between them.

3	If you were at Warren Street near Stockport Town Hall and wanted to get to the DigiKnow Bredbury session on Hipley Close for the 11am class, using the bus, how would you get there?	

4	<p>If you'd just got off a train at Romiley train station from Manchester Piccadilly, what directions would you need to walk from the train station to get to Bredbury Library by midday on a Thursday?</p>	
5	<p>If you lived in Woodley and wanted to volunteer at the Seed Café in Marple, what directions would you need to get there for their session on a Thursday morning at 11am? Use the quickest possible means of getting there.</p>	

6	<p>If you were travelling from Stockport bus station and wanted to be at the COG session at Offerton Community Centre session at 11.20am on a Tuesday morning, using bus and walking only, how would you get there?</p>	
7	<p>If you had finished a session at 12pm on a Wednesday at the Stroke Information building in Stockport and were travelling home to your house on Windsor Drive in Bredbury, how long would it take you to get home using the following means of transport?</p>	<p>Train –</p> <p>Walk –</p> <p>Bus -</p>
